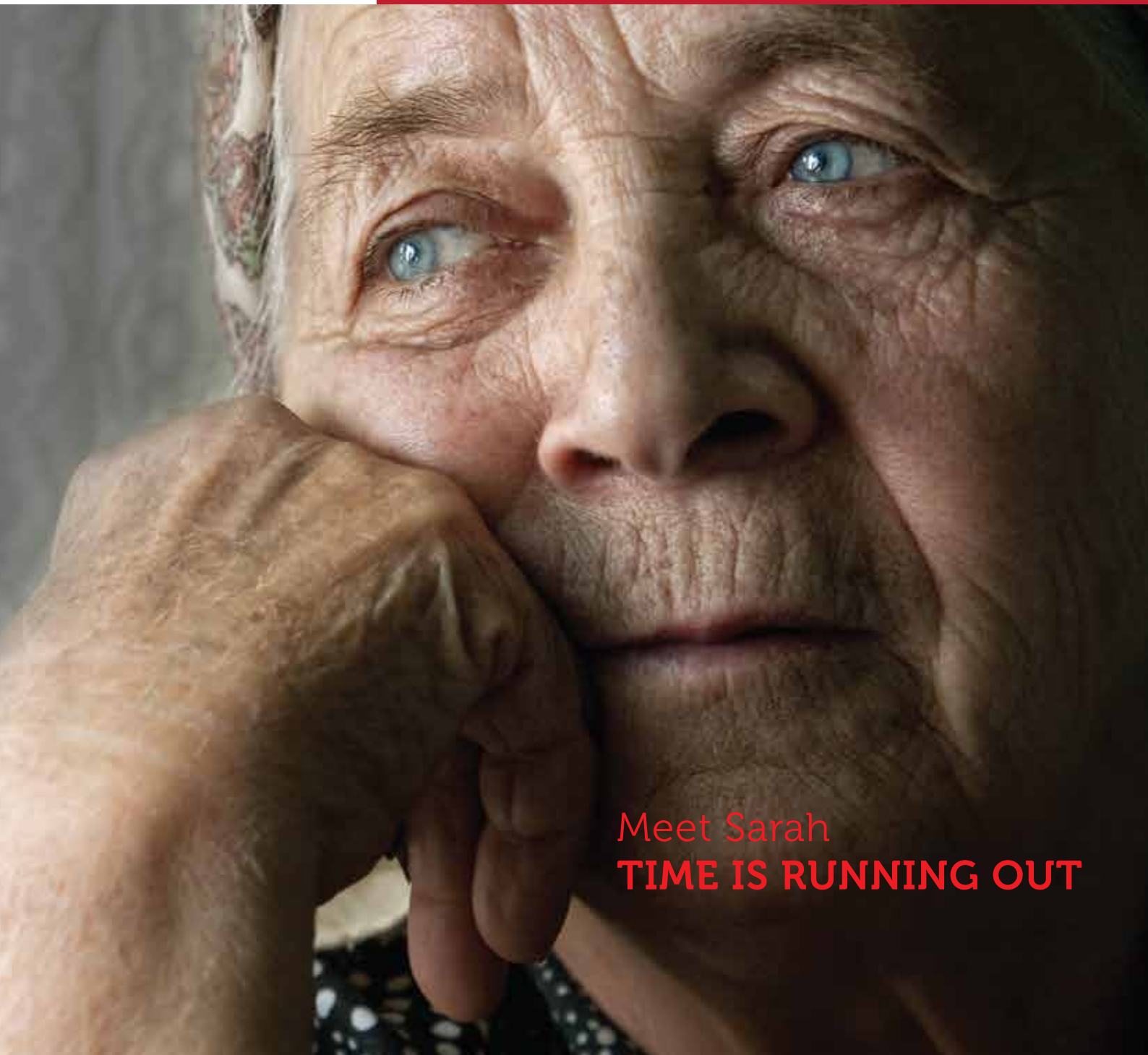


Nini Czopp for Holocaust Survivors –

Meet Sarah
TIME IS RUNNING OUT

Hungary. Dec. 1944

Sarah was a Jewish girl from Budapest. One evening, she was playing at her friend's home when suddenly a siren shrieked and shattered the convivial atmosphere.

The year was 1944. The police barged in and forced Sarah and her friend out of the house. Sarah found herself in a sea of people running through the streets. All alone and terrified, she struggled not to get trampled as she ran for her life.

Sarah, together with her childhood, were snatched up and shipped to Auschwitz. She miraculously survived. At liberation, Sarah found no survivors from her family. Fourteen years old, and alone in the world, she emigrated to Israel and started her life all over again, never fully able to trust others. Today Sarah lives alone. She never married and has no children. She struggles daily with issues of aging and loneliness.

THE FAILURE OF GOVERNMENT TO EFFECTIVELY CARE FOR HOLOCAUST SURVIVORS

Israeli Minister of Welfare Haim Katz admits:

"More than 20,000 Holocaust survivors in Israel never received the government assistance owed to them, amounting to more than \$30 million."

- Sending a social worker to visit survivors in their homes on a regular basis.

- Providing immediate assistance and extended home care following an accident, operation, or acute health crisis. This service is crucial, since, in Israel, governmental allowances are approved only after a complicated and often time-consuming process.
- Relieving the extra suffering from dementia through "A Voice from the Past" that helps survivors work through traumatic memories that have reawakened after years of suppression.
- Arranging for Long Term Nursing Care for those who suffer from chronic illnesses.
- Advising survivors concerning their care and help in pursuing entitlements to services for survivors and their families.
- Guiding relationships and communication between children of survivors and their parents.
- Providing survivors with opportunities to alleviate feelings of unease, frustration and even despair.
